

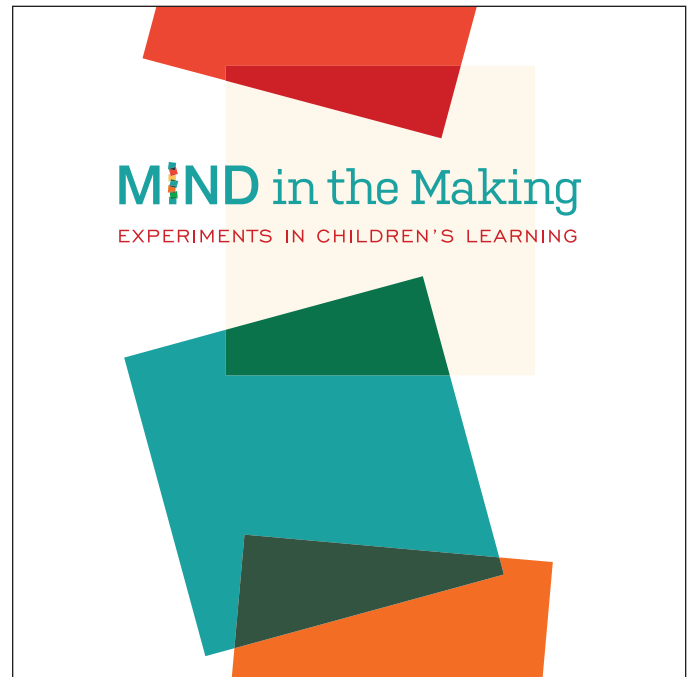
# MIND IN THE MAKING: EXPERIMENTS IN CHILDREN'S LEARNING

This two-volume series of 42 videos take viewers on a series of virtual “field trips” to laboratories in the U.S. and abroad. We film actual experiments in children’s learning—from the classic studies to the cutting edge—conducted by well-known researchers from a number of academic disciplines. The videos show the “researchers in action” as they make important discoveries about how children learn.

The experiments filmed include: the **hypotheses**—what the scientist wanted to investigate and why; the **methodology** used—what method the scientist used to answer his or her questions; the **key findings**—what the scientist learned by conducting this experiment or study; the **implications** of these findings for teaching and caring for children; and **references** for more information and details about the study. These videos can be used in higher education or with any group interested in what we know about children’s learning in the birth through eight years.
